We are seeking a suitably qualified Prosthetist / Orthotist (University Degree) to undertake lecturing duties including:

- **Development of lesson plans and teaching materials**
- **Delivery of lectures and practical demonstrations**
- **Supervision of students in clinical work**
- **Assessment and examination of students**

The language of instruction will be English. The contract duration is 1-2 years, but the term of contract will be on an annual base. Starting date will be on May 20, 2008. Previous experience working in another culture or teaching would be an advantage.

Candidates are eligible to apply for a university academic title such as Assistant Professor, Associate Professor and Professor

1) Prosthetics and Orthotics Program lecturer with the Faculty of Medicine, Siriraj Hospital, Mahidol University

The appointee will be required to:

- a) Develop Thai PO bachelor's degree course.
- b) Conduct and supervise PO courses for PO students from first year to fourth year.
- c) Collaborate with the existing local staff in order to operate PO courses for PO students smoothly.
- d) Assist in improving school P&O facilities.
- e) Cover teaching sessions as assigned by the Chief Lecturer.
- f) Support National staff to prepare and conduct regular testing of student's progress.
- g) Support Thai Assistant Lecturers in the preparation of teaching materials and lesson plans to the standard required by the school.
- h) Arrange training for counterparts as required.
- i) Support National staff in the maintenance of all relevant records of tests and results.

- j) Act as an active member of the curriculum development management committee.
- k) Attend staff supervision and any other meetings required by management.

The Applicant should have:

- a) Bachelor's degree or higher related in P&O field
 - b) Minimum of three years of professional experience in orthotics and prosthetics
 - c) Certification or official qualification in prosthetics and orthotics
 - d) A record of research and publication
 - e) Good command of spoken and written English with high computer literacy
 - f) Teaching experience will be advantage
