The Cambodia Trust is seeking to employ an expatriate Lecturer in Prosthetics-Orthotics for CSPO. Qualifications and recent clinical experience in both prosthetics and orthotics are required.

Responsibilities:

- Train, advise, support and counterpart the National teaching staff
- Provide prosthetics/orthotics theoretical and practical teaching to CSPO students
- Support National staff to prepare and conduct regular testing of student's progress
- Support National staff in the preparation of teaching materials and lesson plans to the standard required by CSPO
- Monitor continuously the quality of work to ensure standards are met according to CT's Quality Management System
- Ensure compliance with ISPO Category II accreditation.
